WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

The only requirements for this grant are: 1) the applicant is a faculty member at the UO (this includes part and full-time instructors and GTFs); 2) the applicant has submitted a proposal for a FLIS presentation; and 3) presents at FLIS 2009.

WHAT'S AVAILABLE?

Yamada Language Center will reimburse the recipient of this grant up to \$1000 for teaching-related professional development expenses. These include: course development, purchase of books, software, equipment, conference attendance, or research assistance.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

Proposals will be evaluated for 3 criteria: need, innovation and willingness to share what is learned. Proposals that will strengthen the teaching and learning of foreign languages at UO will be given top priority. The application itself is below: Please fill out the required information and answer the questions on a separate sheet. Please limit your responses to two pages. Email submissions encouraged.

PREVIOUS AWARDS

Last year Bakony grants were awarded to Racquel Yamada, Linguistics and the Northwest Indian Language Institute, and to the Chinese language program and the World Languages Academy for materials development projects.
